Getting from Vancouver Airport to Downtown Victoria

By Plane:

Air Canada and WestJet fly between Vancouver Airport (YVR) and Victoria Airport (YYJ). Pacific Coastal Airlines offer scheduled service between YVR South Terminal to YYJ Victoria Airport. At Victoria Airport, car rentals YYJ Shuttle and city busses are available to take you to downtown Victoria.

By Scheduled Bus:

The BC Ferries Connector service operated by Wilson's Transportation operates a scheduled service from Vancouver Airport to downtown Victoria. You can purchase bus tickets (which include the ferry fare) online or at the terminals. You can also purchase by calling 1-888-788-8840. To ensure a seat on the bus, you must prepay for tickets (which include the ferry fare) online or by phone. If you plan to buy tickets at the terminal, on the ferry (at the ticket counter for the BC Ferries Connector), or on the bus (when boarding at an enroute pick up/drop off location), you can be turned away if the bus is full and you do not have a reservation. The phone number to make a reservation is 1-888-788-8840.

By City Bus:

Take Canada Line from YVR to Bridgeport Station. At Bridgeport Station, transfer to the #620 Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal bus. This leg of the trip will cost \$4.00 + \$5.00 airport leaving surcharge on weekdays before 6:30 pm and \$2.75 + \$5.00 airport leaving surcharge at all other times. A ferry walk on passenger will pay \$16.25. At Swartz Bay, catch the BC Transit bus #70 Downtown/Airport bus. Cost is \$2.50 and the ride is about 1 hour.

By Car:

With a rental car, travel from the airport along Grant McConachie Way. Go through the intersection for Templeton Street then follow the signs for Highway 99 and Seattle to take the exit (before the Arthur Laing Bridge) angling right to Sea Island Way. Shortly east of Garden City Way, take the exit off Sea Island Way, following the signs from Highway 99 and Seattle. Stay on Highway 99 through the Massey Tunnel. Once through the tunnel, take Exit 28 to travel southwest on Highway 17A. Continue on Highway 17A which soon blends into Highway 17 until you reach the fare booths at the ferry terminal.

Ferry reservations are highly recommended for sailings in the summer for all vehicles. The option is to miss a ferry and have to wait for the next one or perhaps the one after that. Reservations for a standard car are \$15 if made 7 or more days in advance, \$18.50 for less than 7 days in advance, and \$22 for same day travel. You must arrive 60-30 minutes in advance to claim your reservation and pay your ferry fare. A reservation will be forfeited if not claimed by 30 minutes to sailing.
